


MISS WANG HONORED CN-WOMEN'S DAY



THE THEORY OF PRICING

There are 6 main methods by which prices are set by businesses:



MARK-UP PRICING

The most obvious form and common method used is to put a standard mark up on top of total costs. This method is used in every field and can be applied to almost everything. However the standard mark-up often depends on the demand and /or supply of that item. A small seller can buy shoes at 10RMB in China and retail at 15RMB, because people can easily get the transport and packing costs. TARGET-RETURN PRICING

A price that can yield a target profit on the investment; that means, it should be able to repay the investors for their investment.
